


2025 Water and Sewer Rates

Changes Ahead For Your Water Bill

- + A 7.95% rate increase will allow us to continue to provide safe and reliable drinking water.
- + The majority of customers will see a monthly increase of \$4.00 to \$5.50 to their water bill.
- + Our Low Income Credit Program for income-eligible residential customers currently provides a monthly \$8.50 credit towards their water bill. This credit will increase to \$10.50 in 2025.



Customer Bill Benchmarks

CWW service is approximately one penny per gallon of service.

Key Facts

CWW does not receive outside funding (like tax revenue), so customer bills must change to support the financial needs of the system.



Long Term Considerations:

- + Nutrient permit limits based on State requirements
- + Reducing and mitigating PFAS
- + Continuing to control and limit CSOs
- + South plant rebuild given its age and condition



The Rising Costs Of Water




Customer Bills

+ Jan 2025 rate increase: 7.95% Across-the-board
